Once amendments have been made and new members added, a new roll will be displayed from 3rd May to 17th May.

Being on the Parish Electoral Roll enables you to vote at the APCM and sit on the PCC or any other church council

Other News: ECO Tips

Celebrate new life this Easter and have a go at growing something! April is the perfect time to try to grow something edible or, if you are a seasoned gardener, to encourage someone else to try. Salad leaves or herbs are a great place to start and will reduce your reliance on those oh-so-convenient supermarket salad bags. For indoor space, try 'micro-greens' (vegetable leaves harvested soon after they open)

For greenhouses, try sowing salad leaf seed mixes.

For outdoors, beetroot, lettuce, onion and pea plants are frost-resistant, so can all be planted outside in April.

As you sow, thank God for the opportunity to grow food and pray for those communities facing food shortages and famine.
