Big Butterfly Count 17th July - 9th August

This year, All Saints Congleton is taking part in the Big Butterfly Count.

The Big Butterfly Count is a nationwide citizen science survey aimed at helping to assess the health of our environment. Butterflies are a vital part of the ecosystem as both pollinators and components of the food chain.

However, they are under threat. Numbers have decreased significantly since the 1970s. Tracking the number of butterflies is crucial to conserving our natural world.

To take part, simply count butterflies for 15 minutes during bright, preferably sunny weather. A butterfly identification chart will be provided. We will then add our count to the Big Butterfly Count App. Watch this space for further details in the coming weeks. If you cannot join the church count, why not take part in your own garden or park, or go for a walk?
